Wicca, they morphed into the foundation stones of a new symbol: the Witch's Pyramid. That pyramid would be crowned with the mysteries of Spirit and a new maxim, the Wiccan Rede. However, that is only half the story! Hermetic magick reveals a mirror reflection of the God/dess in balance, both projective and receptive, like the yin/yang. This workshop presents an expanded symbolical structure: The Witch's Jewel of Power as the Octahedron, including the receptive elemental tools of cooperation culminating as the missing maxim of the Goddess: Perfect Love and Perfect Trustworthiness. **81 Goddesses Chant

Created in 2004 by Mina Familiar-Ragsdale and Sarah Familiar-Ragsdale, and chanted by MJ Dellucci, a Crone Priestess, 81 Goddesses is a devotion which utilizes a special set of prayer beads invented for this purpose. The strand is segmented into sets of nine beads, which are referred to as "muses." Each set corresponds to nine Goddesses, drawn from diverse traditions to reflect our divine heritage. Each set of these beads are hand knotted, are available for use, and may be purchased if desired. Granted proprietary status as caretaker of the 81 Goddesses chant, MJ has taken 81 Goddesses on the road, and has chanted all along the east coast. Our goal is to continue this practice and eventually have the names chanted throughout the world. It is our hope that you will recognize at least one name in this list of 81 Goddesses that is sacred to you, and that by honoring that one, you will find that, even though the stories and names are different, the Divine energy inherent in each is the same. The New Zealand people also perform the Haka to honor people, whether when a mentor retires or when someone has passed away and they perform it as a blessing to the spirit of the loved one who has passed on. You can see videos of the Haka performed by U.S. sports teams, flash mobs, someone's graduation or birthday party. It has been a regular staple at FPG's maypole for many years. (All Ages Welcome)

The Maypole started as an ancient Germanic Pagan fertility rite. A ceremonial folk dance is performed around a tall pole hung with ribbons that are woven into a pattern by the dancers. Typically performed on May Day; Maypole dances occur at midsummer events in Scandinavia and has been incorporated in Folk festivals all over Europe. In Neopaganism the Maypole continues to be a symbol of fertility, be it sexual, physical, emotional or spiritual. The Maypole dance will be a ritual of blessing the Goddess Earth in preparation for the God's phallus symbol (the maypole). If you've never danced a Maypole before, that's OK, we will teach you the dance. (All Ages Welcome)
