#### ***Norse Symbel***

Symbel is the most community-oriented of the three Norse Rites. In symbel we sit with those dear to us and celebrate them and others, including our ancestors and those who are heroes and examples to us. It is said that the best way to describe what is done during a Symbel is "Toasts, Boasts and Oaths". Sometimes we toast the gods in symbel, but it is primarily a rite to celebrate humanity. Symbel is a drinking rite. The participants sit in a circle (often around a fire if outdoors), in a rectangle around the sides of a room, or around a table, and going clockwise, each makes a toast (or a boast or an oath, or offers a poem or song), raises the horn or other drinking vessel, says "Hail ... !" In 1888, the Hermetic Order of the Golden Dawn was founded in England. This was a time and place where Masonry, Rosicrucianism, and Secret Societies proliferated - though very few of them engaged in what we would call magick or occultism. The Golden Dawn was something new - or perhaps a revival of something far more ancient. It focused almost entirely upon occultism, admitted both sexes on an equal basis, and launched the modern occult revival that would eventually lead to further magickal orders, Thelema and the OTO, and even Wicca and Neopaganism. The G.D. gave us the modern West's most famous wizards - Samuel "MacGregor" Mathers, Aleister Crowley, Florence Farr, William Butler Yeats, Maud Gonne, A.E. Waite, Dion Fortune, Israel Regardie, and others. So who were these people? What was the purpose of the Golden Dawn? What did they do back then? How did it influence the modern occult revival? And, are they still around today? We will explore these questions and many more in this lecture. (All Ages Welcome)

Sugar skulls are colorfully decorated with icing, pieces of bright foil, colored sugars and usually bear the name of the deceased loved one being honored. They are easy to make by children and adults, and if kept dry, they can last a year.

During this two day, hands-on workshop, attendees will make their own henna, learn about different application techniques, safety protocols, and easy patterns to combine into a piece of art unique to each person. Discussion points will also include history, traditional uses, and the meaning of various symbols across cultures where henna is endemic.

I have given many lectures about the Solomonic tradition of magick - usually focused on its medieval/renaissance origins, and its development into our current age. I have even discussed specific magickal techniques, such as invocations and spirit-feeding, drawn from the Old Magick. However, I have yet to show what the greater tradition looks like in practice today. What is life like for a practitioner of the medieval grimoires in the modern world? How does it differ from other modern occult traditions? Solomonic magick is far more than a set of tools to be employed at need by the magician; it is, in fact, a way of life - requiring lifelong dedication and devotion to one's personal guardians and familiar spirits. In this workshop we will explore the daily practice of a Solomonic conjurer and, perhaps most importantly, see how the Old Ways relate (or could relate) to your own practice. (All Ages Welcome)

After all, there are grimoires full of angels and nature spirits who have no connection to the infernal realm. There is really nothing "Satanic" about these books. However... While it is true most of this negative reputation is thanks to aggressive anti-occult propaganda from the Church, the grimoires themselves must bear some of the blame. While there are plenty of angelic grimoires out there, it cannot be denied there are countless examples of grimoires that really do call upon Satan, Lucifer, Leviathan, Belial, Asmodeus, Baal, Lilith and hundreds (maybe thousands) of other denizens of hell. This made it very easy for the Church to hold the texts up as proof that they are, in fact, devilish at heart.

Yet the European medieval/renaissance grimoires were primarily produced by devout Christians. The image of the defrocked priest performing Satanic Masses behind closed doors is not only the stuff of urban legend, but nothing

remotely like it appears in the grimoires. Even the spells that call exclusively upon the rulers of Hell still make prayers and appeals to the Highest God to accomplish their goals. So these people weren't Satan worshippers or even demonolaters - but that leaves us to question: why in the world would devout Christian mystics even include Satan or anything hellish in their grimoires? And, of course, what does that mean for those of us using the same texts today?

You might find the answer surprising - but more importantly you will see how the answer is vital to the Western mysteries, and to all of us attempting to revive the Old Magick in the modern world. This lecture might just change how you think magick works! (All Ages Welcome)
